

## Two Days National Seminar EXCELLENCE, EQUITY AND EXPANSION IN HIGHER EDUCATION 13-14 June 2017

### Executive Summary

A two days National Seminar on “*Excellence, Equity and Expansion in Higher Education (3EHE-2017)*” was organized by Aishwarya College of Education Sansthan (NAAC Accredited and approved under UGC sections 2(f) and 12(B), permanently affiliated by M L Sukhadia University, Udaipur) in collaboration with Janardan Rai Nagar Vidyapeeth (Deemed) University (NAAC accredited grade A), Udaipur on 13<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 at Department of Computer Science and IT, JRNRV Campus which was attended by more than 100 delegates.

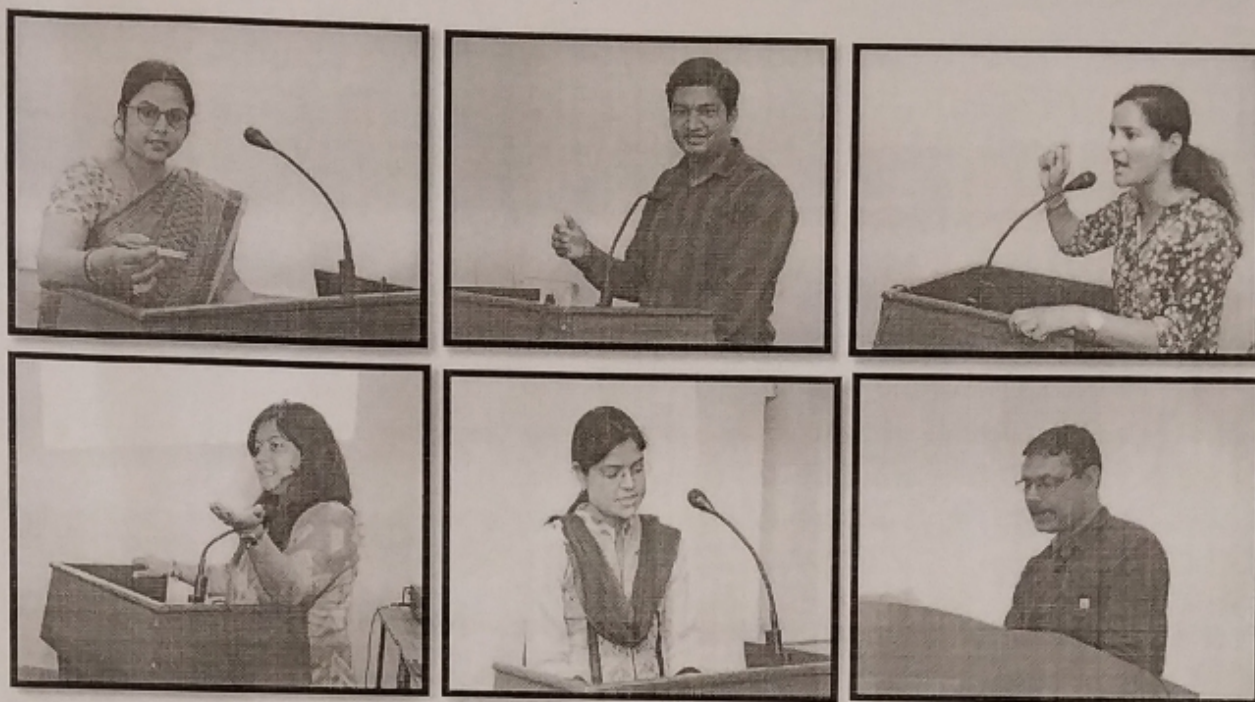
Mathur, Prof. Paresh Shah and Prof. Asha Arora.
